REPUTATION

Northshore Boats has been manufacturing quality fibreglass boats in Perth, Western Australia, since 1957. In the early years, the company earned an enviable reputation for 'building Surveyed Commercial Boats. Later, it expanded its operations and built recreational fibreglass boats of up to 15 metres.

In the mid '90s, Northshore Boats was steered in a new direction by a talented commercial boat builder. He used Northshore's good reputation, plus extensive market research to focus on what today's boat owners' want tomorrow.

The first new generation eye-catching models sets a new benchmark for quality and innovation in boat manufacturing.

Welcome aboard to the Northshore 850 CR Cabin Runabout.

CONSTRUCTION

Tremendous pressure is placed on the underside of all boat hulls so Northshore has built the hull with cutting edge construction on the 850 CR to take the punishment, even in heavy sea conditions.

Each 850 CR hull starts with a lay'up of tri-axial and double-bias glass matting, plus applying a outer skin Gelcoat called Maxguard ISO-NPG, considered to be the best Gelcoat in the industry. The structure is nothing less than strong throughout using similar building to commercial survey methods, giving a solid hull structure of a 16mm thick keel, 12mm thick chines, 8mm thick hull and side panels and 6mm thick upper deck sections.

Many boats in any type of sea conditions tend to vibrate severely, which is generally caused by a thinner hull structure. The 850 CR performs with minimum flex and vibration in any sea conditions, due to applying a commercial standard hull thickness coupled with a three piece hull, deck and floor ensuring you enjoy your offshore cruising with maximum comfort and driveability.

Plywood is also used in many boats to form the cockpit floor and add strength. Over time wood rot becomes a problem. To avoid this, Northshore applies a 20mm high-density foam moulded to the floor to keep the weight down but maintain the hull's structural integrity throughout.

STABILITY

The 850 CR has a finely tuned and balanced configuration of length x beam x weight x hull design. It is a truly stable craft with solid construction based on a commercial survey philosophy. Northshore customers who are experienced fisherman say the 850 CR is surprisingly stable when two to three keen fisherman working their rods on one side of the boat. When it comes to being sea sick, less rock in a boat is a good boat for fishing.

Size is everything, and the 850 CR offers a deceptively spacious cabin and cockpit, plus substantial room for either three fishermen working on one side of the boat or a family of six enjoying a day of cruising, skiing or just soaking up the sun and enjoying the boating lifestyle.

SAFETY

The height of the internal gunwales is 810mm. This means the hip bone area of a 1.8m tall person would be near level with the top edge of the gunwale. Kids under 10 years would have a greater level of protection



from falling overboard with their chest to shoulders area leaning safely against the top edge of the gunwale. This safety aspect is a big plus for families. For added safety, the fishing part of the boat (the sides) have toe support channels along the cockpit floor, with a non-skid surface strip. This is invaluable when you are reeling the big one in and landing it, without loosing your footing in choppy conditions.

LAYOUT

Standard seating is for four people with an optional removable transom lounge to seat extra people. A lined V berth cabin can be used for storage and/or a midday nap for the kids on the cabin bunks. A marine toilet is an option in the V bunk section and for privacy, you can choose again as an option between a zip up canvas cabin door or lock-up split saloon doors. There is abundant storage from stem to stern with full length moulded shelves in the cabin, compartments under the sleeping bunks, cockpit side pockets and inside the box pedestals on the captain and passenger chairs.

Under the cockpit floor there is a generous 145 litre fuel tank and a 150 litre fully insulated kill tank fitted with drainage bungs. Fishing or picnicking is a breeze with the standard dual purpose live bait tank/ice chest moulded in the transom with an access door that doubles as a bait cutting board. Optional is a

removable icebox that also works as a transom access door. It can be removed from the boat and used as a portable esky, when you have anchored at your favourite bay or hideaway.

WARRANTY

Northshore Boats provides a seven-year structural hull warranty on all its models, that's how confident the company is about its manufacturing processes. Northshore gives you complete peace of mind in your investment.
